PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Presented by noted dermatologists and quality-assured by Bond University (Australia), the Professional Diploma of General Dermatology program will teach you how to manage all major dermatological conditions as well as general disease states manifesting through the skin, and help you minimise unnecessary referrals to specialists. Upon completion of the program, participants have the opportunity to visit and observe some of the presenters in their facilities through the Dermatology Clinical Attachment program.

The Professional Certificate course will teach how to diagnose various dermatological conditions in the early presentation stage and choose appropriate treatment options for common skin, hair and nail problems. In the Advanced Certificate course, you will increase your clinical knowledge, learn how to assess more complex and rare cases, and make differential diagnoses for various dermatological conditions. In the Professional Diploma course, you will develop the most advanced clinical knowledge and critical awareness of dermatology principles and treatment options.

The three online certificate courses must be completed in sequential order to qualify for the professional diploma.

POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

Postgraduate Diploma of Dermatology awarded by the University of Plymouth (UK)

HealthCert graduates are eligible to apply for Accreditation of Prior Certified Learning (APCL) for module 3 of the Postgraduate Diploma in Dermatology studied through the Rila Institute of Health Sciences and awarded by the University of Plymouth (UK). There are three modules in the postgraduate diploma which is mainly delivered online. No practical workshops will be required due to the APCL from the HealthCert qualifications. Overall there will be a time saving of 30 per cent of the postgraduate program due to the APCL. Supervised examinations will need to be completed in the United Arab Emirates campus.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The three-part program is aimed at qualified medical professionals with an interest in general dermatology. No previous formal training is required for the Professional Certificate course. Participants of the Advanced Certificate course must have successfully completed the Professional Certificate or have equivalent qualifications. To qualify for the Professional Diploma, participants must complete the Professional and Advanced Certificate courses in sequential order. Other professionally accredited qualifications and prior studies may be recognised for entry into the program.

ALL COURSES INCLUDE

- Digital workbook including all presentation slides a highly valuable reference source for your practice.
- Access to additional learning resources, reference materials and video lectures.
- Reading list with references to peer-reviewed journal articles to keep up-to-date with developments in the field.
- 12 months web-based support with the opportunity to ask the instructors questions while you implement your learning.

COURSE DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

The three-part program is delivered online over 15 weeks with 12 weeks of teaching followed by three weeks for revision and final examinations. Each course consists of eight modules and includes online presentations from experts in the field followed by patient case discussions and decision-making.
