

30 May 2018, Athens

Arrival in Athens

31 May 2018, Athens

After breakfast, you will be picked up from the hotel for a full-day Athens tour, which offers an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Our expert guides will take you to see the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of modern times was held in 1896. Pass by the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, Parliament, the memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the university, the National Library, and Constitution Square (Syntagma).

On the Acropolis visit the architectural masterpieces of the golden age of Athens: the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally the monument that "puts order in the mind", the Parthenon. Continue to the Acropolis Museum to admire the wonders of the classical era.

After lunch in a local restaurant, drive along the coastal road, passing the wonderful beaches of Glyfada, Vouliagmeni and Varkiza to the most southern point of Attica, Cape Sounion, where the white marble pillars of the Temple of Poseidon stand. On the way, you will have a splendid view of the Saronic Gulf and the little islands offshore. After visiting the Temple of Poseidon, you have time to walk at leisure on the rocky promontory of Sounion.

1 June 2018, Athens

Seven-day cruise commences on the private yacht charter, Harmony V.

2 June 2018, Marina Zea or Piraeus, Poros

Make your own way to Marina Zea for embarkation between 2-3pm. Enjoy a welcome drink and meet your crew and fellow passengers. Sail for Poros for a short three hour visit, before setting sail to Poliegos. Overnight at sea.

3 June 2018, Poliegos - Folegandros

Morning arrival in Poliegos, a very small island known for its amazing beaches. Morning swim stop followed by a barbecue on deck. Afternoon sailing to Folegandros, one of the most amazing and lesser-known islands in the Aegean Sea. Walk the amazing upper city and dine at one of the traditional Greek tavernas.

4 June 2018, Santorini

Morning arrival at Santorini (occasionally at anchor) to explore its unique capital Fira. Optional excursion to Akrotiri excavations and a tour of the villages including the small village of Oia, known for its breathtaking view over the caldera. Overnight in Santorini.

5 June 2018, Antiparos, Paros

In the morning, enjoy a swim stop in an enchanting bay in Antiparos. Early noon arrival in Paros. Visit Parikia and the quaint village of Naoussa. Time to have a fun night and show us your dancing skills during our famous Greek Night. Overnight in Paros.

6 June 2018, Delos (anchorage), Mykonos

Optional morning tour to the unique archaeological site of Delos, antiquity's most sacred island. Later on, you will stop at one of Mykonos' beautiful bays for swimming off the ship before sailing into the port of Mykonos. The island of the jet setters is yours to explore and the night is young. Overnight in Mykonos.

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7 June 2018, Syros

After a morning swim, you will arrive in Syros, the capital of the Cycladic islands where you can enjoy one of its beautiful sandy beaches or walk through the town to view the unique architecture of the buildings. Overnight in Syros.

8 June 2018, Zea/Piraeus, Athens

In the morning, arrive in Kythnos where you will enjoy a swim in Kolones Bay. Then set sail for Marina Zea, arriving in the late afternoon via Cape Sounion, the temple of Poseidon. Overnight in Marina Zea.

9 June 2018, Marina Zea/Piraeus, Athens

Disembark from your cruise after breakfast and transfer to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure. In the evening, you will be picked up from your hotel for dinner at Dionysos Restaurant.

Perched on a hillside, it has an expansive patio surrounded by pine trees, facing the Acropolis. The restaurant has its past glories where Aristotle Onasis and other prominent Athenians loved to dine.

The restaurant is frequented by politicians and well-known Athenians who come to enjoy the modern twist on traditional Greek and Mediterranean cuisine in the restaurant's special atmosphere. Dedicated to modern Greek cuisine, the menu reflects the culinary philosophy of Chef Achilles Papachristou of mixing disparate materials, and uses fresh raw ingredients and favourite recipes from the Mediterranean tradition.

10 June 2018, Athens, Nafplion

After breakfast, you will be collected from your hotel at a pre-appointed time to start your tour. Depart Athens via the scenic coastal road to the Corinth Canal for a short stop. Drive on and visit the Theatre of Epidauros, famous for its remarkable acoustics. Then proceed to the town of Nafplion to enjoy a free afternoon.

11 June 2018, Nafplion, Olympia

Enjoy a free morning in Nafplion before travelling to Mycenae and visiting the archaeological site and the Tomb of Agamemnon. Continue through the central Peloponnese and the towns of Tripolis and Megalopolis to Olympia, birthplace of the Olympic Games, for an overnight stay.

In the morning, visit Olympia's archaeological site where you will see the Sanctuary of Olympian Zeus, the Ancient Stadium and the Archaeological Museum. Drive on through the plains of Eliad and Achaia to the magnificent new bridge crossing the Corinthian Bay from Rion to Antirion. Pass by the picturesque towns of Nafpaktos (Lepanto) and Itea as we make our way to Delphi for the night.

12 June 2018, Delphi, Kalambaka

In the morning, visit the Delphi archaeological site and Museum. Depart for Kalambaka, a small town situated at the foot of the astonishing complex of Meteora's gigantic rock pillars. Overnight in Kalambaka.

13 June 2018, Kalambaka, Thessaloniki

Visit the spectacular monasteries of Meteora, where you can see exquisite specimens of Byzantine Art. Continue onto Thessaloniki, Greece's second largest most vibrant city where the tour concludes.
