

Windows 10 Enterprise for the NHS



Will you be ready for the 2020 Deadline?

The Department for Health and Social Care have signed an agreement with Microsoft that will see NHS devices upgraded to a Windows 10 Enterprise License (E5) if you sign with Bytes. This version is free and includes Advanced Threat Protection (ATP). But what does this mean for your organisation?

Deadline Date:
14th January
2020

This is the date by which you must have migrated your full estate to Windows 10.

This is also the date when Windows 7 will no longer be supported and will therefore leave your organisation at risk of a cyber attack.



How do I obtain the licenses?

- You will have to sign a service agreement with **Bytes**
- This agreement will only cover the cost of licensing
- You must then deploy Windows 10 internally or with a partner



Agreement terminates:

30th January
2023

What happens to our current Windows 10 contract?

- Microsoft replaces this with the new NHS Digital National Agreement
- Join before your next annual payment date to avoid additional payments



What are the key terms of the Service Agreement?

You must:

- implement Advanced Threat Protection throughout your agreement
- continually share your ATP info with NHS Digital data security
- provide accurate forecasts of the devices required for software asset management purposes
