## BWL Hometown Energy Savers® Participating Contractors Policy

BWL Hometown Energy Savers is a portfolio of programs promoting energy efficiency and conservation, including rebates and education. The program offers financial incentives to participating building owners and contractors.

Contractors who meet certain training and program participation standards are given Participating Contractor status.

The Hometown Energy Savers Participating Contractors Policy and Application define the terms under which the contractor agrees to participate in the Participating Contractor program.

### **Participating Contractor standards include:**

- Maintaining good customer service performance and representing the Hometown Energy Savers program appropriately.
- Attending an annual training session and submitting a signed participation agreement.
- Submitting at least one application per program year.
- Submitting final application paperwork within 90 days of the funds reservation letter.

### **Benefits of participation include:**

- Access to free exclusive program training.
- Access to the Participating Contractor Portal on the BWL Hometown Energy Savers website.
- Your company listed as a registered Participating Contractor on the BWL Hometown Energy Savers website.
- Supplies of printed marketing materials.
- An assigned Energy Advisor to assist with the program.
- Eligibility to receive third party checks.

The program team will review all applications, verify the information and contact the references listed. If any information is missing or inadequate, we will contact you to request an update. You will be notified via email when your application is approved.

### **Restrictions:**

- Applicant must be either an installer, a general contractor, an architecture and engineering firm, or a supplier of qualifying equipment to be eligible.
- Use of the BWL logo in any format is strictly prohibited without the express written approval of the program.
- Co-branding is not allowed and will result in removal as a Participating Contractor.
- Participating Contractors may provide a link to the list of approved Participating Contractors on the BWL Hometown Energy Savers website.
