Sue Page is our Success Story for the month of June. Ms. Page was admitted to Superior Care home after a fall in which she sustained compression fractures in her spine. She lives independently and was very active prior to the fall and injury.



Initially her pain scale was 8/10 upon admission, her balance needed improvement, and she was only able to walk 5 feet with assistance and a walker. Ms. Page received physical and occupational therapies that included electrical stimulation to help with her pain and muscle spasms. At discharge, she is able to ambulate independently unlimited distances, with and without a rollator walker. Her pain has decreased and her fall risk is now considered low since her balance has improved. She is independent in transfers and bed mobility and is ready to return home safely!
