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Our Superior Success Story

Deloris Futrell *Rehabilitation* "They won't let you give up!"

Our latest success story is truly a story of determination. Delores Futrell was working on her farm in the St. John area of McCracken County. She fell from her tractor and sustained extensive injuries to her lower extremities.

Initially her pain was a big factor in the rehabilitation process. She was unable to bear weight on either leg, had difficulty sitting and needed assistance with most activities of daily living. Her range of motion was limited due to her strength and activity tolerance.

During her stay, Ms. Futrell participated fully and made consistent progress along with modifications due to her limited weight bearing status.

At discharge, her pain has decreased significantly. She is able to walk with a rolling walker 200 feet, and she is able to transfer and to negotiate up to 4 steps.

"I feel stronger now than even before my accident" shared Futrell. "I am thankful for all the therapists who helped me-Kelly, Jennifer and Christine! I have enjoyed the food, especially the breakfast options. I would recommend Superior Care to anyone needing rehabilitation. It has all been so good!"

Superior Care Home's Rehabilitation gyms are equipped with state of the art therapy machines.

Ms. Futrell's therapy sessions included the Omnicycle (pictured right), which is a motorized rehabilitation system that uses a "smart motor" to help patients exercise and increase range of motion when they have limited strength, endurance or muscle control.

In addition to the Omnicycle, Ms. Futrell used the Scifit Recumbent Stepper (below left). This machine's arm to leg movement encourages activities of daily living like climbing the stairs.



"Our focus is to help our residents attain their best possible outcomes, and with our cutting edge therapy gyms and equipment and dedicated and encouraging therapists, our residents will reach their goals in a timely matter, so they can "Get Well & Go Home!" shared Mary Jo Sprouse, Encore Rehabilitation Director.


News and Notes Holiday Dinner Times Get
