An Incident Response Plan is a set of policies, procedures, roles, and responsibilities that enables an organization to effectively respond to security events and mitigate the negative impacts on business operations.

An Incident Response Plan provides an organization with the foundation to bring needed resources together in an organized manner to deal with an adverse event related to the safety and security of personnel, systems, and data. An effective Incident Response Plan will help to mitigate the risks from cybersecurity incidents by providing guidelines on responding to incidents efficiently and effectively, and will ensure security response maturity through effective planning, development, testing, and training.
