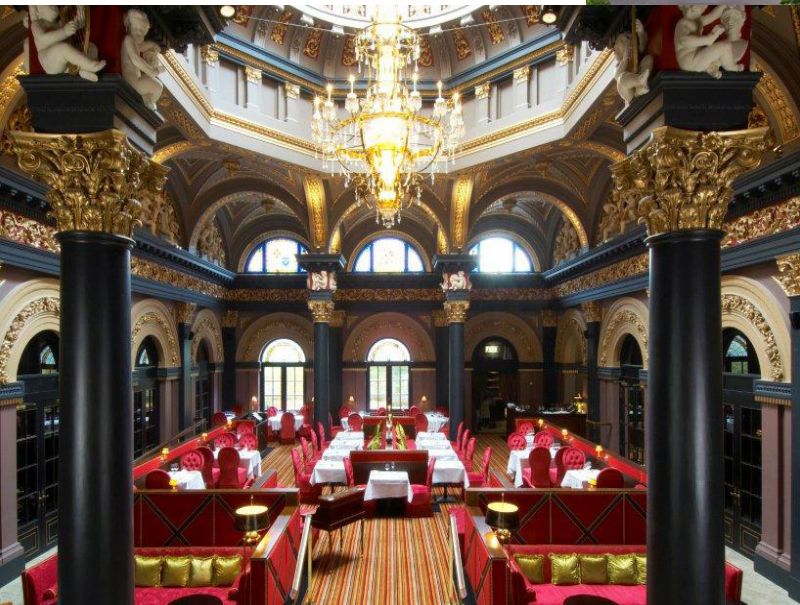

PORTSTEWART - STRAND

Founded in 1894 and redesigned by Willie Park, Jr. in the 1920's, this championship links course received its greatest makeover with the purchase of land known as "Thistly Hollow" in 1981. The Strand Course is the jewel in the Portstewart portfolio.



ROYAL PORTRUSH

Royal Portrush Golf Club is home to one of the best and most challenging links golf courses in the world, the Dunluce Links, and the hidden gem, the Valley Links. Royal Portrush is the only club in Ireland to have hosted The Open Championship.



ROYAL COUNTY DOWN - CHAMPIONSHIP

Royal County Down Golf Club is located in one of the world's most naturally beautiful links settings. Against the magnificent backdrop of the Mountains of Mourne, the World Ranked #1 golf course zigzags back and forth to provide a different view from virtually every hole.

Ranked amongst the top golf courses in the world, Portmarnock is arguably one of the best Championship Courses in Ireland. The course layout has been completely crafted by the natural land and is surrounded by water on 3 sides. Ooften at the mercy of the wind, Portmarnock is quite a formidable test for golfers of any skill level, which is why it has become quite the popular location for some of golf's biggest competitions including the Walker Cup, the Irish Open and the Canada Cup.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT N. IRELAND & IRELAND

Q: What airports should I plan to fly in and out of?

A: You'll want to schedule your flight to arrive and depart from the Dublin International Airport (DUB). Dublin Airport. Your first round of golf at County Louth is approximately 50 minutes from the Dublin Airport.

Q: What will the weather be like during our stay?

A: A typical day in N. Ireland & Ireland in April could bring a bit of sunshine, clouds, mist, rain, and wind. The average temperature for April-September is typically 50-75 Fahrenheit. Extremes are rare in N. Ireland & Ireland, as it tends to not be overly warm or cold.

Q: What currency is used in N. Ireland & Ireland?

A: The British Sterling Pound (GBP) is the currency used throughout N. Ireland. The GBP is currently trading at approximately 1.26 US Dollars to the GBP. The Euro is the currency used throughout Ireland and is currently trading at 1.12 US Dollars to the Euro.

Q: Will I be able to get cash and use credit cards while in N. Ireland & Ireland?

A: You will find that most major credit cards and debits cards are nearly universally accepted in N. Ireland & Ireland. The same is true of Travelers cheques, which should be in Pounds to avoid extra exchange rate charges. ATMs are ubiquitous throughout N. Ireland & Ireland so you will have easy access to cash. It should be noted that American Express is not as widely accepted in the UK as Visa and MasterCard.

Q: What is the cancellation policy for this Experience?

A: All deposits and final payments are non refundable. However, we highly recommend purchasing a travel insurance program through Travel Guard and we will be happy to provide a quote for The Tee Tour & Travel policy. This policy will allow you to cancel for a variety of reasons and receive a full refund of all fees paid, including airfare. Please contact a GG Concierge if you would like a quote for travel insurance.

Q: What if I want to play additional and optional golf?

A: There are plenty of championship links courses around the area you'll be staying at in N. Ireland & Ireland! If any Guest wants to play additional golf, even at the spur of the moment, a member of the GG Concierge Team can arrange optional golf for you.
