What: Create an art piece representing a food grown, raised or harvested in Oregon such as blueberries, pears, milk, salmon, carrots, kale and more.

Deadline: Submit by July 1 2020

To Submit: Complete entry form. Mail your art and entry form to Josephine County Extension Office at 215 Ringuette, Grants Pass, OR 97527 or take a picture of your art and email to <u>Sharon.evans@oregonstate.edu</u> or you can bring it to the OSU Extension office (with the entry form) and deposit it in the mail slot to the right side of the front door.

Contest Rules:

- 1. Art media include markers, crayon, watercolor, ink, acrylic, tempera paint or colored pencil. <u>No</u> pastel, chalk, pencil or 3-dimensional or digital art.
- 2. Entries must be 11 by 8.5 inches, HORIZONTAL pictures only.
- 3. All entries must include signed entry form.

Guidelines:

- Draw your featured item in its natural environment such as growing or grazing in a field, during harvest, or being served at the table such as a bowl of berries or a fluffy salad.
- Include something that represents the Southern Oregon area such as osprey, eagles, fish, evergreen trees, mountains, the Rogue River, your school mascot or other features you see around you.
- Not sure what foods aregrown and produced in Oregon? Visit our website, the Grants Pass Grower's Market Farmers Market or look at the Oregon Ag in the classroom interactive map.

All local entries will be displayed in an online gallery and/or in downtown Grants Pass for a community art walk.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes awarded in two age categories (K-3 and 4-6 grades). Entries judged on: creativity, neatness and representation of Oregon Agriculture. Prizes include OSU gear, art/science kits, Grants Pass Grower Markets coupons and more!
