






#### Total Fertility Rate per 1000 Women, 2016



#### Total Fertility Rate Per 1000 Women





### Projected Change in Numbers of High-School Graduates, 2012 to 2028





Question: Are headcounts the right way to think about future demand for higher education?

#### Example:

Person A: Asian-American woman living in Boston with both parents who each hold a BA and earn \$125,000

Person B: Hispanic man living in rural California with his mother who holds no degree and earns \$40,000

Probability of attending four-year college or university:

Person A = 96%

Person B = 9%


Probability of attending four-year college or university ranked among top 50:

Person A = 73%


Person B = 2%


Basic Concept: Probability-weighted demand forecasts






## Forecasted growth in students who will attend a <u>two-year</u> institution, 2012 to 2029




## Forecasted growth in students who will attend a <u>regional four-year</u> institution, 2012 to 2029




## Forecasted growth in students who will attend a <u>national four-year</u> institution, 2012 to 2029




## Forecasted growth in students who will attend a <u>elite four-year</u> institution, 2012 to 2029




#### Forecasted Number of Students Attending College by Institution Type and Year of High School Graduation




## Race/ethnicity distribution of students attending four-year institutions, 2012 and 2029



## Parental education distribution of students attending four-year institutions, 2012 and 2029




## Geographic distribution of students attending four-year institutions, 2012 and 2029





### The Cost of Diversity

- Dominant Narrative: Trade-offs in admissions process—diversity vs. NFI.
- Alternate Narrative #1: With increasingly diverse prospective student pools, failure to reach and retain diverse students leads to enrollment contraction.
- Alternate Narrative #2: Failure to reach and retain diverse students risks losing the hearts of WASP-y generation Z prospective students.

- Expanded recruitment (eg to reduce enrollment differences by race and/or income)
- Change in recruitment activities to target growth areas
- Continued reductions in public funding
- Continued pressure on tenure
- Increased attention to retention
- Increased international student recruitment
- Closures and consolidation

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



### Surge in Hispanic Enrollment




