Results Summary

We received 85 responses to the survey, and we appreciated the time taken by relatives to respond as it helps us identify where we need to improve.

The results for Anthony Wilding are exceptional – 96% of relatives rated the overall experience as good or very good, compared to 75% for the industry. A significant number of relatives described the staff as "friendly and caring" and expressed how pleased they are with the level of care. Several people commented on the "beautiful surroundings" and pleasant atmosphere at Anthony Wilding. There was a substantial improvement in the last year regarding the communication of GP visits and housekeeping. Activities rated higher than last year, but has been identified as an area to improve further. The area which attracted the most comment was our laundry service, with people expressing concern about lost or damaged clothing. We are reviewing our laundry services Ryman-wide and we are committed to making changes to our systems so that we get this right.
