

## Airline Reward Programs

Carrier	Remarks
<b>Air Canada</b>	All Air Canada Altitude status for 2020 will automatically be extended to the end of 2021. If a member does reach a higher status tier before the end of the year, they'll still enjoy that status, and will maintain it for next year as well.
<b>Alaska Air Lines</b>	Alaska Air Lines is extending all status that's set to expire on December 31, 2020, by 12 months. That means all active Mileage Plan status will be valid through December 31, 2021. Members will receive all the usual tier benefits for 2021.
<b>American Airlines</b>	American Airlines is extending current AAdvantage elite status for its members through January 31, 2022. The carrier is also lowering elite and Executive Platinum reward qualification requirements for this year and extending the expiration dates for Admiral Club memberships and one-day passes by six months.
<b>Avianca</b>	The LifeMiles rating system will have a reduction in the rating requirements. Which will be informed in due course. The enabler of miles flown with Avianca remains at 60%. Flexibility to book with miles up until June 30, 2020. The expiration of miles that were scheduled between April 1 and December 31, 2020 will be paused.
<b>British Airways</b>	British airways announced that it has lowered elite qualifying requirements for select Executive Club members. Elite members with a status renewal date April - June of this year can requalify for status renewal date in April, May and June of this year can requalify for status with 30% few Tier Points.
<b>Cathay Pacific</b>	Cathay Pacific is granting members bonus points to help make up for lost travel. These will be granted in monthly increments to Marco Polo Club members and represent only a portion of the points needed to retain status
<b>Delta Air Lines</b>	Delta SkyMiles will be extending current Medallion status by 12 months. That means whatever status you have right now will be valid throughout 2021, and into early 2022. All other programs and card benefits will extend between six months – one year.
<b>Emirates</b>	Existing Emirates Skywards Silver, Gold and Platinum members can requalify for status by meeting 80% of the travel requirements for their respective status tier this year. All flights completed before January 30, 2020 will receive 20% more Tier Miles towards status qualification.
<b>Etihad Airways</b>	Etihad Airways announced that beginning March 31, 2020, it will distribute bonus Tier Miles to all Etihad Guest members on a monthly basis in order to help them maintain elite status. Etihad is offering double tier points on all trips taken between March 1 and June 30, 2020.
<b>Flying Blue</b>	The loyalty program of Air France, KLM and other carriers has announced that it would lower the elite status requirements for all members with a qualification period ending in March, April or May 2020. Flying Blue is also pausing expiration of miles through the end of 2020 for all members and allowing free changes and cancellation for award tickets.
<b>Hainan Airlines and Hong Kong Airlines</b>	Fortune Wings, the loyalty program used by Hainan Airlines, Hong Kong Airlines and other Chinese carriers has automatically extended elite status validity for elite members. Elite status members who are set to lose their current elite status tier will have their elite status extended for up to 14 months.
<b>Hawaiian Airlines</b>	Hawaiian Airlines noted that it plans to reduce the number of miles and segments needed to qualify for elite status in 2021. Not expiring any miles from March 21, 2020 through December 31, 2020. Members with miles set to expire within this period will retain their full mileage balance. For those who are enrolled in the Premier Club, your membership will be extended by 3 months.
<b>JetBlue</b>	Mosaic elite status is being extended through December 31, 2021. To earn elite status, JetBlue is qualifying threshold by 50%.
<b>LATAM</b>	LATAM has extended status validity for all LATAM Pass elite members through March 2022.
<b>Qantas Airways</b>	Qantas will be applying an automatic 12-month extension to the membership tier status for eligible Qantas Frequent Flyers
<b>Qatar Airways</b>	Qatar Airways will be expanding coverage for its loyalty program, Privilege Club, by extending or reinstating tier status for 12 months, for memberships due to expire before January 31, 2021.

<b>Singapore Airlines</b>	Singapore Airlines announced that they will be automatically renewing all KrisFlyer Elite and PPS Club membership statuses for another 12 months at the end of their membership year. The validity of any expiring PPS and Elite Gold rewards will be extended until March 31, 2021.
<b>Southwest</b>	For all current A-List and A-List Preferred Members, Southwest is extending your current earned status through December 31, 2021. If you are a current Companion Pass Member, Southwest is extending your current earned Companion Pass benefits through June 30, 2021. All Rapid Reward Members will be receiving a “boost” of 15,000 tier qualifying points and 10 flight credits towards A-List and A-List Preferred status, and 25,000 Companion Pass qualifying points and 25 flight credits toward Companion Pass status.
<b>Turkish Airlines</b>	Turkish Airlines announced that it is extending elite status validity for all Miles&Smiles elite members by six months.
<b>United Air Lines</b>	United MileagePlus is extending current Premier status by 12 months. Which means whatever status you have right now will be valid throughout 2021, and into early 2022.
<b>Virgin Atlantic</b>	Virgin Atlantic announced that it was extending status for Gold and Silver members by six months.
<b>WestJet</b>	WestJet is extending the validity on unredeemed companion vouchers expiring in March, April, or May 2020 and companion vouchers with an earlier expiry date, that were redeemed for travel between March 1 and June 30, 2020 where travel was canceled due to COVID-19. Extended or upgrade members who were on track to achieve status in March, April or May will continue to look after those whose tier status may be impacted in the months ahead.

## Hotel Reward Programs

Hotel	Remarks
<b>Accor</b>	Accor announced that all Accor Live Limitless (ALL) tiers of status will be extended an additional year for all members residing in Greater China, including the mainland, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan. These statuses will now expire December 31, 2021.
<b>Best Western</b>	Best Western Hotels and Resorts is helping its loyalty members retain their elite status with Best Western Rewards. Effective immediately, all BWR members globally will maintain their current status through January 31, 2022 without needing to fulfill the necessary qualifications.
<b>Choice Hotels</b>	Choice Hotels has paused expiration until May 31, 2020 allowing Choice Privileges members more time to redeem points and achieve greater flexibility when planning future travel.
<b>Hilton</b>	All members whose 2019 status was scheduled to be downgraded on March 31, 2020 will automatically receive an extension through March 31, 2021. Hilton will be pausing the expiration of all points scheduled to expire between now and December 31st, 2020. In addition, Hilton is extending your 2020-member status through March 31, 2022.
<b>Hyatt</b>	Hyatt hotels is giving its World of Hyatt loyalty program members a one-year extension on the elite benefits that they earn. Unused Free Night, Suite Upgrade, or Club Lounge Access awards with an expiration between March 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020, will get a free extension through December 31, 2021. Points from inactive accounts that were due to expire this year will now remain active through December 31, 2020.
<b>IHG</b>	IHG Elite status never expire. For all other club members, points only expire after 12 months of inactivity. If your points were due to expire from April 1, IHG is extending the expiration date to December 31, 2020
<b>Marriott</b>	Marriott is giving their Marriott Bonvoy members both Status Extensions and Points Expiration. Status Extension: The status you earned in 2019 will be extended to February 2022. Points Expiration: To provide you ample time to redeem points, the expiration of points will be paused until February 2021.
<b>Omni Hotels &amp; Resorts</b>	For members who did not re-achieve their Platinum or Black Level status last year: We did not process downgrades at the end of February. We extended status through the end of 2020. For members who earned or re-achieved status in 2019: We extended status through the end of 2021.
<b>Preferred Hotels &amp; Resorts</b>	The I Prefer reward program announced that all elite members will retain their status through June 31, 2021, regardless of the number of nights they complete this year. It's also extending points expiration for all members through August 31, 2020.
<b>Radisson Hotels</b>	Radisson Hotels is suspending its point expiration policy by six months, effective March 1, 2020. Radisson has also extended the elite status of their members through February 2022, for those who that would have expired in February 2021.

## Rewards Programs Reference Sheet

<b>Shangri-La Hotels and Resorts</b>	Though it's a smaller program, Shangri-La has decided to extend all Golden Circle tier status members (Diamond and Jade) around the globe through December 31, 2021.
<b>Wyndham Hotels</b>	Wyndham is pausing the expiration of any Wyndham Reward points until September 30, 2020 and have extended current Wyndham Rewards Members Levels (status) for all members globally through the end of 2021.

### Car Rental Reward Program

Agency	Remarks
<b>Avis Budget Group</b>	Avis has automatically extended their current Avis Preferred status through January 15, 2022, regardless of their 2020 rental activity. This applies to all Avis Preferred status – Avis Preferred Plus, President's Club, and Chairman's club.
<b>Enterprise</b>	Enterprise is extending Enterprise Plus points expiring in March, April and May of 2020. If you are a current Enterprise Elite member, you will receive a one-year status extension. If you are a Silver, Gold or Platinum level member with a tier expiration date of 2/28/2021, your current status will extend through 2/28/2022.
<b>National</b>	Elite status will be extended. Current Executive and Executive Elite members will tier set to expire on February 28, 2021 will receive a one-year extension and keep their status through February 28, 2022. Qualifying rentals and rental days will roll over.
