**ORDER**

In accordance with the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Plaintiffs’ Motion to Enforce Consent Judgment (Doc. # 16) is **GRANTED**. On May 27, 2014, acting pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1071(b), this court issued a Final Consent Judgment vacating the Board’s July 23, 2013 decision on the HOUNDSTOOTH MAFIA mark, Opposition No. 91187103. The United States Patent and Trademark Office Trademark Trial and Appeal Board has heretofore failed to effectuate that Final Consent Judgment. **Within fourteen (14) days of this order**, the USPTO Trademark Trial and Appeal Board is **ENJOINED TO AND SHALL VACATE** its July 23, 2013 Opinion on Opposition No. 91187103, and otherwise take any further action necessary to effectuate this Order and the Court’s May 27, 2014 Final Consent Judgment, including permitting the HOUNDSTOOTH MAFIA & Design Application (Serial No. 77/342,852) to be registered on the Principal Register with the University as its owner.

2. The Motion by Michelle K. Lee, Undersecretary for Intellectual Property and Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, to Intervene (Doc. # 28) is **DENIED**.
