The role will be technically intensive and you should be prepared to get stuck in and cut code yourself whilst providing guidance as technical lead to your team. You will run quick and efficient meetings and make sure that the team always knows what to do and how to do it.

Required knowledge and experience

- You need to be a Java rock star. Normally this means 10+ years development experience. We write and run most of our applications, so you'll need to be comfortable in an environment with a 24/7 uptime expectation.
- You need similar skills with ancillary tools like Maven, XML, HTML, CSS and Javascript
- Our databases run into the hundreds of gigs, so strong RDBMS skills are a must. We use MySQL, but any RDBMS will do.
- 3+ years in a role exercising technical leadership. This can be as a team leader, senior developer or scrum master.
- The role combines technical leadership, line management, and project management. There will be plenty of hands-on development, but you need to be as talented working with people as you are with code.
- Programming is a team sport and you can work with and improve someone else's code just as well as your own.
- We have an open culture where people are given responsibility, so you need to be able to work with business and product stakeholders to understand and deliver requirements
- We follow scrum fairly closely, so you need be comfortable working in an agile environment
- An ability to quickly and effectively understand and translate product and business requirements into technical solutions whilst adhering to the agreed specification
- You will be responsible for the team's Jira boards and code quality. We are
 in the process of migrating from SVN to git, and a grounding in all of
 those tools will be helpful
- An understanding of Agile development methodologies and XP techniques,
 Scrum master certification or similar a distinct advantage



- It's great if you have used anything in our ecosystem which includes Jenkins, eclipse, git, SVN, MySQL, tomcat, Vaadin, Jersey, Jackson, Ubuntu, OpenNebula and docker
- Knowledge of Javascript frameworks such as Angular, Knockout, Polymer, or ReactJS
- We're really big on testing, so being a whiz with Selenium, Cucumber or other BDD frameworks is a huge plus
- Experience in financial services.

Qualifications
