



RAPIDIDENTITY PRODUCT TRAINING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the difference between the Foundations and Advanced courses?

Foundations provides attendees with a high-level overview of the key functionality of RapidIdentity's components and modules. Building on what is learned in Foundations, the Advanced course introduces more complex concepts and teaches the skills necessary to participate in a full identity lifecycle implementation using RapidIdentity. For Foundations, a pre-installed RapidIdentity appliance with minimal configuration is provided, while Advanced allows participants to fully configure the RapidIdentity appliance. Both courses are hands-on, however, Foundations takes a more instructor-guided approach.

Do I need to take both courses?

All Identity Automation system integrators are required to take both courses. Customers or partners wishing to take the RapidIdentity Advanced Product Training must first complete the Foundations course.

When participants complete the courses, do they receive a certification?

Upon successful completion of either course, participants will receive a RapidIdentity Training Certificate. Identity Automation also offers a certification exam to become a Certified RapidIdentity Administrator.

How large is the class size?

RapidIdentity training classes average between 10 and 25 participants. A minimum of five (5) attendees per class is required for a class to be held.

What happens if there is a schedule change?

In the event of a schedule change prior to classes, Identity Automation will notify attendees at least ten (10) business days before the original start date of the class. Identity Automation is not be responsible for reimbursing prepaid customer travel costs due to a class cancellation. It's recommended that customers who elect to incur travel costs for an instructor-led training class schedule and purchase airfare and hotel accommodations with this in mind.

Are laptops or computers provided for onsite training?

Participants are required to bring their own laptops with a Flash-enabled web browser. Please confirm this prior to attending the training. Visit <https://www.whatismybrowser.com/detect/is-flash-installed>.

Each participant receives access to a pre-configured, cloud hosted virtual environment in Amazon AWS with RapidIdentity software for the duration of the course.

Where does the onsite training take place?

I.A. Training Facility, 7102 N Sam Houston Pkwy W, Houston, TX 77064. The I.A. training facility is approximately 15 miles west of the George Bush Intercontinental Airport and about 35 miles north of the William P. Hobby Airport.

Does Identity Automation offer training in other locations?

Does the fee include my travel costs?
