Over the years, in the FBI and in private practice, Jay has conducted over 300 interrogations and led over 100 investigations into possible securities violations. Jay has an extensive network of high-level relationships throughout the state and federal law enforcement communities.

A decorated public servant, Jay was awarded the U.S. Customs Service Directors Commendation in 1999, New York City FBI Special Agent of the Month for September 2000, and FBI Director's Commendation in 2001.
