Job Purpose Summary:

Under the supervision of the Maintenance Supervisor, the Maintenance Technician is primarily responsible for performing general/preventive maintenance and repairs on all equipment, as well as facility maintenance in compliance with established safety rules, policies and procedures.

Principal Job Responsibilities:

-)] Provide emergency/unscheduled repairs of production equipment during production and performs scheduled maintenance repairs of production equipment.
-)] Strong mechanical aptitude including, but not limited to, mechanical, electrical, pneumatic, hydraulic, troubleshooting and repair of production machines.
-)] Read and interpret equipment manuals, schematics/blueprints and work orders to perform required maintenance and service.
-)] Diagnose problems, replace or repair parts, test and make adjustments.
-)] Perform regular preventive maintenance on machines, equipment and plant facilities.
-)] Ability to accomplish general and preventative maintenance tasks for Plant coolant system towers to safety/operational specifications.
-)] Perform general and preventative maintenance requirements for all types of pumps (centrifugal, reciprocating, vane, etc.) to safety/operational specs.
-)] Complete assigned work orders in a timely and professional manner.
-)] Demonstrate a strong safety conscience
-)] Willingly perform proper Lockout/Tag out procedures
-)] Self-starter yet able to take orders as directed
