Major Update: Submitting and Grading the Blue Planet Report

When we launched BioBeyond, we wanted to include an experience where students created a report that developed their critical thinking and writing skills – that is the Blue Planet Report. But it didn't work perfectly for you, so this release focussed on improving the experience.

Student Experience: Submitting the Blue Planet Report

Until now, students had to print the report to PDF and then submit it to you via email or LMS. Your students may have reported issues with printing, submitting, and/or re-submitting it.

From now on, students will be able to submit their Blue Planet directly from the BioBeyond Learnspace. Students will go to the final lesson in Unit 7: "Submit Your Report", and from there, they can click on the submit button.

We will incorporate new instructions for students once the current semester is finished.

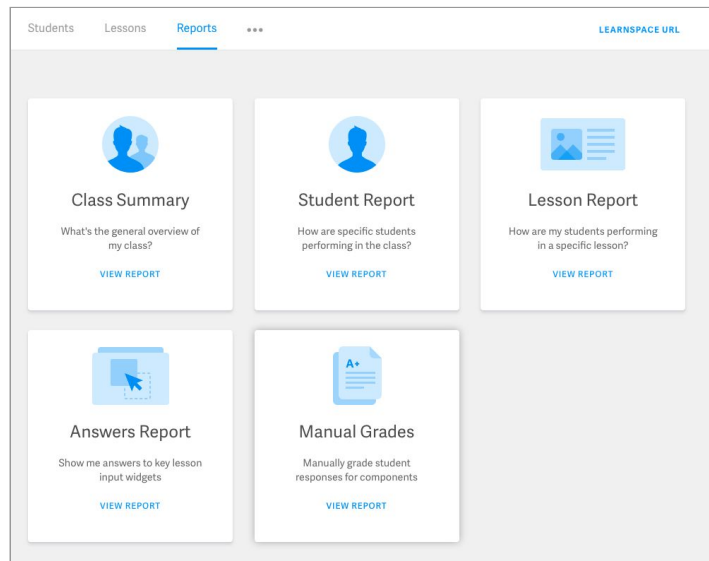
Instructor Experience: Grading the Blue Planet Report

You can now grade the Blue Planet Report from within Smart Sparrow.

Under the Reports tab, select “Manual Grades”. You can score a student’s component out of 556, and then assign the grade.

NOTE: The score for the report (out of 556) is now included in the total grade for BioBeyond. (Total is now 8,007)

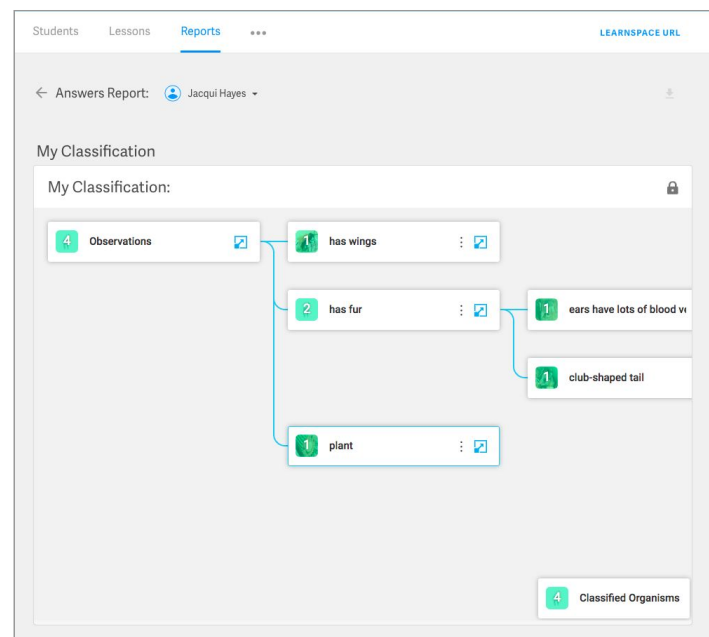


Major Update: Seeing Students’ Classification Project

There was one simulation in Unit 7 Blue Planet built using Adobe Flash. Internet browsers have been disabling Flash, making it a more and more frustrating experience for students. Our support team are a fun crowd, but we understand that you don't want to email them every time your students start Unit 7. We replaced the simulation. Thanks for sticking with us while we work to remove Flash from our products.

Recommended Browser: Google Chrome

Google Chrome has returned to the top spot as the recommended browser for students using BioBeyond. Your students should have a smoother experience generally due to recent updates.
