Improving the Safety of Compounded Preparations - USP <800> Compliance

Course Description

This new USP chapter becomes official on July 1, 2018 and is on the minds of all pharmacists and pharmacy technicians who handle hazardous drugs (HD's). To help our customers prepare for the impending implementation of USP Chapter <800> - Handling in Healthcare Settings in August 2018, Spectrum is providing this seminar outlining the standards and covering the core principles of the chapter - protecting personnel, patients and the environment from exposure to HD's.
