



SUGGESTED FORMULA

Animal Treats

Version number: 1.0

Quantity: qs

Powdered Animal Food	13.2 g
Glycerin, USP	2 mL
Flavor Liquid	1 mL
Gelatin Base	6.6 g
Active Drug	qs

SUGGESTED COMPOUNDING PROCEDURES

1. Accurately weigh or measure each ingredient
2. Cut gelatin base into small pieces and put into beaker put into a beaker in a water bath
3. Mix the powdered animal food with the active drug powder
4. Mix the flavor with the glycerin and add to the melted gelatin
5. Incorporate the powdered animal food:active drug
6. Fill the desired molds and allow to set until hardened (molds should be calibrated prior to finalizing formulation)

Store in air-tight container, refrigerated.

Beyond-Use Date estimated to be **30 days per USP <795>**.

General: Precautions should be taken to prevent cross-contamination and exposure of ingredients to the compounder and contamination of the preparation by the compounder. Wear appropriate protective equipment . Use safety enclosures (hoods) when weighing and mixing.
