Powdered Animal Food	13.2 g	
Glycerin, USP	2 mL	
Flavor Liquid	1 mL	
Gelatin Base	6.6 g	
Active Drug	qs	

SUGGESTED COMPOUNDING PROCEDURES

- 1. Accurately weigh or measure each ingredient
- 2. Cut gelatin base into small pieces and put into beaker put into a beaker in a water bath
- 3. Mix the powdered animal food with the active drug powder
- 4. Mix the flavor with the glycerin and add to the melted gelatin
- 5. Incorporate the powdered animal food:active drug
- 6. Fill the desired molds and allow to set until hardened (molds should be calibrated prior to finalizing formulation)

Store in air-tight container, refrigerated.

Beyond-Use Date estimated to be 30 days per USP <795>.
