

Silk-Screen File Preparation Guidelines

Correct preparation of original artwork is critical for timely delivery of your product. You can avoid delays and additional charges by following these recommended guidelines.

Software and File Formats

Original vector artwork must be made, saved and sent in one of the programs listed below.

In order of preference:

- Adobe® Illustrator® (CS3 or lower version) - .ai
- Adobe® Photoshop® (CS3 or lower version) - .eps, .psd
- QuarkXpress™

If you are unsure about whether your software and/or format is acceptable, please contact your Roland representative.

Type Copy & Line Art

- Type, logos, and illustrations should be provided in one of the formats listed above, not as bitmapped art
- We can also scan your original transparency, color or B&W print.
- Business cards and photos are not recommended and will result in a less than desired product.

Color

- All colors should be specified as Pantone call-outs (PMS) or Roland curtain color
- If Pantone colors (PMS) cannot be supplied, please provide a physical sample (color proof, swatch, etc.) for matching purposes.

Fonts

- We have many fonts, but if your artwork contains an unusual font, please include it with your artwork or convert the font to outlines/paths.

Sending Artwork

- Your artwork/image and any necessary info may be uploaded to our FTP site. See your Roland representative for more details.
