HISTORIC MONACO CITY TOUR INCLUSIVE OF LUNCH (With One- & Four-Night Packages)

After enjoying your last breakfast on the ship, you'll disembark the ship to embark on your adventure in Monte Carlo.

For seven centuries the Grimaldi Family has presided over the Principality of Monaco, one of the longest ruling families in Europe. This rare dynastic longevity is proof of national unity between the Princes and the Monegasque people.

Today, you'll explore the historical part of Monaco taking you to Monaco-Ville, le rocher or the rock, a veritable open-air museum with its narrow streets, arched alleyways and old houses and numerous sculpted lintels. Here you will visit the Monaco Cathedral, built in 1875, a Romanesque-Byzantine burial place of past sovereigns, including Prince Rainier and Princess Grace. Inside, an altarpiece can be seen by the painter from Nice, Louis Bréa, dating back to 1500.

Here you will also make your way to the Oceanographic Museum of Monaco, founded by H.S.H. Prince Albert II of Monaco's great-great-grandfather, Prince Albert I, is a museum of marine sciences in Monaco-Ville, Monaco. It is home to the Mediterranean Science Commission and has been watching over the oceans for more than a century. This building is part of the Oceanographic Institute which is committed to sharing its knowledge of the oceans.

Next, you'll visit the Prince's Palace of Monaco, originally built as the Genoese fortress in 1191, has a long dramatic history of being bombarded and besieged by many foreign powers. It has been the home and stronghold of the Grimaldi family since they first captured it in 1297 and is the official residence to the Sovereign Prince of Monaco. While here you'll also be able to see the Palatine Chapel and the Main Courtyard, where concerts by the Monte-Carlo Philharmonic Orchestra take place every summer.

After all your exploring of Monaco, you'll have worked up an appetite so your next stop will be for lunch at Restaurant A'Trego. With a beautiful setting right on the water, you will enjoy a lovely Mediterranean lunch before being taken to the Fairmont Monaco Hotel.

The rest of the day and evening are yours to explore Monaco on your own.



PARIS ORIENTATION CITY TOUR INCLUSIVE OF LUNCH (With Four-Night Paris Package Only)

After a leisurely breakfast in Monte Carlo on October 13, you'll board your coach to head for the Nice airport where you'll catch your flight for Paris!

Once you arrive in Paris, you will be met by your English-speaking guide who will bring you to your awaiting coach. You will start your Paris Orientation Tour by way of the historical city during which the guide will give you an introduction to the city.

Once downtown, you'll go past the most important highlights of Paris, the world-famous Champs Elysées, the Arc de Triomphe and the Place de la Concorde. You will also discover the Seine river and understand why the Parisians are speaking of the Rive Gauche, the southern bank of the river, and the Rive Droite, the northern bank or the river and where the Seine divides the city into north and south zones. You'll stop for your first Parisian meal with a lunch at a bistro style restaurant before continuing your orientation of the Paris.

After lunch, you'll continue with your exploration of the different neighborhoods of Saint Germain des Prés, the Opéra district, Invalides and of course, see the famous Eiffel Tower, built on the Champ de Mars and named after the engineer whose company designed and built tower, Gustave Eiffel! Here you'll have a photo stop before continuing to your hotel for check in.

This evening will be free for you to have dinner and explore Paris on your own.



FULL DAY LE MARAIS AND MONTMARTRE INCLUSIVE OF LUNCH (With Four-Night Paris Packages)

After breakfast, you'll board your coach for your full-day tour exploring two of Paris' famous neighborhoods, Le Marais and Montmartre! First, you'll be taken to the fashionable Marais District, the true aristocratic Paris with its renaissance mansions, courtyards, small narrow streets and squares. Once the city's Jewish quarter, as you walk the small streets you'll pass by Jewish shops, kosher restaurants, and synagogue. Here, you'll see the Place des Vosges, originally Place Royale, the oldest planned square in Paris and probably the most beautiful square in the world with its vaulted arcades lined with art galleries, antique stores, hip boutiques, and gay bars.

Next, you'll board your coach again for Montmartre, another must-see district of Paris with a totally different atmosphere! The charming Montmartre district which sits on a hilltop, also known as La Butte, is a former artists' village once inhabited by Picasso and Dalí and is home to the domed Sacré-Coeur basilica.

Your journey to Montmartre begins with a ride on the funicular (cable car) up to the top of the hill to discover the old village square and the Church of St-Pierre de Montmartre, one of the oldest churches in Paris, built in 1147 and was the prestigious Montmartre Abbey. Here, you will also enjoy the most spectacular views of Paris and the ever-impressive Sacré-Cœur basilica.

Upon arrival, you'll enjoy a wonderful lunch at La Cremaillere restaurant, located on the main square of the village, before having some time to stroll around the small streets filled with cute shops, cafes, patisseries and chocolateries as well as visit the Sacré-Coeur. You can also wander around the main square of the village, Place du Tertre, with its bustling atmosphere, painters, caricaturists, street artists and souvenir shops.

After enjoying your day taking in the history and culture and Le Marais and Montmartre, you will arrive back to your hotel and have the evening free for dinner and further exploration of Paris on your own.



HALF DAY PARIS ISLANDS TOUR (With Four-Night Paris Package Only)

After breakfast, you'll board your coach for your half day tour of Paris' two natural islands located on Seine in the center of the city, Île St. Louis and Île de La Cite.

Île de la Cité, the cradle of Paris, is the biggest of the islands with its history dating back to the city's very beginnings. Though redeveloped between 1853 and 1870 to bring it in line with Baron Haussmann's new vision for the city, the island still retains a few extraordinary examples of medieval architecture, most famously the Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Paris. In addition to the Cathédrale Notre-Dame, you'll pass by Sainte Chapelle, Conciergerie, a medieval royal palace that became a revolutionary tribunal and Marie-Antoinette's prison, the hidden 17th century square, Place Dauphine, and many parks, bars and restaurants before crossing the bridge to explore Île St. Louis.

After crossing the bridge you'll be on the Île Saint Louis, named after King Louis IX of France when the island was created in the early 17th century, today, is one of the prettiest neighborhoods in Paris. The island was formerly used for the grazing of market cattle and stocking wood. However, now you will see architecture that keeps intact the imprint of the late French Renaissance period, as well as small streets lined with boutiques, art galleries, restaurants, Poplar-shaded quays bordered with noble facades, some of the nicest views of the city, and will likely succumb to the charm of this Enchanted Isle.

This afternoon you can choose to go back to the hotel with the coach or stay on the Paris Island to continue exploring, enjoy a hot drink, a "crêpe" or an ice cream at the famed Berthillon, known for its luxury ice cream and sorbet.
