idX expands North Carolina offices, adds 50 jobs

Works with state officials through building reuse program

ST. LOUIS, MO--idX Corporation, a global leader in the manufacturing of consumer environments, is working with North Carolina state officials to create new employment opportunities at its idX Impressions facility in Washington, NC.

With the support of the N.C. Rural Infrastructure Authority (RIA), idX Impressions will expand its Washington offices by 25,000 square feet, adding a showroom and training center. In the process, the company will add 50 new full-time jobs, more than half of which will be manufacturing.

The RIA's Building Reuse Program awarded idX a \$500,000 grant to renovate the uninhabited space, which was formerly occupied by Hamilton Beach.

"idX is bringing jobs back to America," said idX CEO Terry Schultz. "Working with North Carolina's Rural Infrastructure Authority, we were able to accelerate our plans for growth in the community."
