

## **2017 – Course Fees and Census Dates**

(Effective from 1 January 2017 – 31 December 2017)

The following pages contain information about Minerva College's course fees and census dates in relation to VET student loans.

As you may commence your course at any time, the actual census dates that apply to your course will be individual to you. Your letter of offer will state the census date for your *first* unit of study based on your course commencement date that you select in your application.

Once you have completed a unit of study within your course, and before you can commence your next unit of study, you will be asked to confirm the next unit of study's commencement date. You will then be informed of the census date that applies to that unit of study based on its commencement date.

## Example

Jane has applied to study the BSB50215 Diploma of Business and has decided to commence her studies on **9 January 2017**. Her letter of offer informs her that the census date for her *first* unit of study is **30 January 2017** as the census date for this unit of study is 21 days after commencement.

Jane then completes her first unit of study in 15 weeks, finishing on 21 April 2017.

Minerva College contacts Jane to confirm when she would like to commence her *second* unit of study. Jane states that she would like to have a one week break before commencing her second unit of study on **1 May 2017**. Minerva College informs Jane that her census date for the second unit of study is **22 May 2017** as the census date for this unit of study is **21** days after commencement.

Jane then completes her second unit of study in 15 weeks, finishing on 11 August 2017.



Again, Minerva College contacts Jane to confirm when she would like to commence her *third* unit of study. Jane states that she does not want a break before commencing her *third* unit of study on **14 August 2017**. Minerva College informs Jane that her census date for the third unit of study is **4 September 2017** as the census date for this unit of study is 21 days after commencement.
