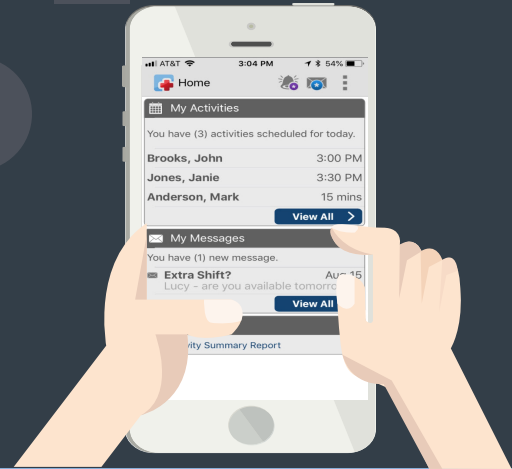


What is EVV and CellTrak?

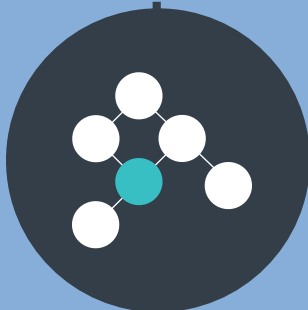


The 21st Century Cures Act mandates that states establish policies for Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) of Medicaid-funded home care.

EVV is a system that requires providers to confirm that services were actually delivered through a variety of electronic methods for each service.



CellTrak's mobile apps and interactive voice response (IVR) are used by hundreds of agencies to collect EVV and other real-time data at the point of care.



Data must have the following elements to be compliant with EVV:

- Service type
- Individual receiving the service
- Date of service
- Location of service delivery
- Individual providing the service
- Begin and end times of service

EVV is a legal requirement that will ensure that we are compliant with the 21st Century Cures Act.
