Qualifications:

Scholarships will be awarded competitively by the NHAEF board or its designees, based on the following criteria:

HIGH SCHOOL –

- Student is a legal resident of New Hampshire;
- Student has a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 GPA;
- If not in an automotive, diesel or collision repair program, student must have 4 years of math.
- Student has a valid NH driver's license. Scholarships may be denied if applicant is 19 y/o or under has two or more points or of a 20 y/o or older has three or more points. If you are insurable and employed, this will be taken into consideration.

COLLEGE (Additional qualifications) –

- Student is attending one of the programs listed at left; and
- Student is working in the industry of the program in which enrolled.

What You Will Need to Apply:

- Completed Scholarship Application;
- Your most recent transcript;
- A signed letter of recommendation from your automotive, diesel or collision repair instructor (1ST YEAR STUDENTS ONLY)

An incomplete application will not be reviewed. Please review your application carefully before submitting it.

Deadline is April 1st for the following school year, beginning in the Fall semester.
