## Qualifications:

Scholarships will be awarded competitively by the NHAEF board or its designees, based on the following criteria:

### *High School:*

- Student is a legal resident of New Hampshire;
- Student has a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5;
- If not in an automotive, diesel or collision repair program, student must have 4 years of math.
- Student has a valid NH driver's license. Scholarships may be denied if applicant is 19 y/o or under, has two or more points; or if a 20 y/o or older has three or more points. If you are insurable and employed, this will be taken into consideration.

### *College:*

- Student is attending one of the programs listed at left; and
- Student is working in the industry of the program in which enrolled at a NH Dealer
- Student has a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 GPA;
- Student has a valid NH driver's license. Scholarships be denied if applicant is 19 y/o or under, has two or more points or if a 20 y/o or older has three or more points. If you are insurable and employed, this will be taken into consideration.

### *What You Will Need to Apply:*

- Completed scholarship application;
- Your most recent transcript;
- A signed letter of recommendation from your automotive, diesel or collision repair instructor.

***An incomplete application will not be reviewed. Please review your application carefully before submitting it.***

### *When to Apply:*

Deadline is April 1st for the following school year, beginning in the Fall semester.
