

Qualification format for NHADA Competition

All automotive high school ASE-EF programs are invited to have level 2 and/or level 3 seniors compete in the NH State Competition. All students participating in the competition must be in good standing at their school and scheduled to graduate that year. This is a 2 phase competition consisting of the following guidelines.

Phase 1

- *Is a written test given to each student who meets the above requirements.*
- *The test consists of 100 questions to be completed.*
- *Each student is able to receive up to 100 points.*
- *The top two students' scores will be combined for an available total of up to 200pts.*
- *Top 10 teams will be invited to compete at the hands-on competition portion.*

Phase 2

- *Is a hands-on competition.*
- *There are up to 500 points to be gained at the level*
- *The top ten teams from written are invited to participate*

The overall champion will be decided by who has the most combined points, with a total combined score up to 700pts (written 200 and skill 500)

Guidelines

- *Prior to teams being invited to phase 2, if a student in 1st or 2nd chooses to take them self out of the competition the 3rd place written test winner will be named and score will be updated to reflexed the team that will represent that school.*
- *Once the top 10 schools have been named, if an auto program has a student that can not or chooses not to compete that school can not subsitute another student and no other school will be added.*
- *If a member of the team or the team is not at the competition at the start time, the team will be forced to sit out until both members arrive. Penalties will be given and they will not be able to complete missed stations.*

The overall Champion and Coach will compete at the NY Auto Show and represent NHADA.
