ORDER

Upon consideration of the parties' Joint Motion to Enter Judgment and Final Order, and the entire record in this matter;

It is hereby:

ORDERED that the parties' Joint Motion is hereby GRANTED.

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is directed to enter the proposed Judgment and Final Order filed with the parties' Joint Motion.


ORDERED that defendant shall pay plaintiff the lump sum amount of \$1,030,000.00 (One Million Thirty-Thousand Dollars and No Cents), without withholding, deduction or other set-off, to the Client Trust Account of plaintiff's counsel in accordance with payment and wiring instructions provided by plaintiff's counsel, with post-judgment interest allowed on the Judgment on the Verdict [ECF #104] to the extent authorized by law.

ORDERED that defendant shall take all steps necessary to process the foregoing payment as soon as practicable, in accordance with the practices and procedures of the U.S. Department of Justice and the U.S. Department of the Treasury or other agency of the federal government responsible for making payment.



ORDERED that defendant shall restore 634.2 hours of annual leave, 235.15 hours of sick leave, and 45.5 hours of comp time to plaintiff's leave account; to allow plaintiff to use such leave when requested by plaintiff in accordance with agency procedures and policies until December 31, 2019; without withholding approval unreasonably; and to advise plaintiff's counsel by email or other written notice no later than thirty days from the entry of this Order that the foregoing leave has been restored.

FURTHER ORDERED that this case is concluded in its entirety, subject to being re-opened solely for the purpose of enforcement. See Kokkenen v. Guardian Life Insurance Co. of America, 511 U.S. 375, 381-82 (1994).

JUDGMENT

This case was tried before a jury and a Judgment on the Verdict in favor of plaintiff Terri L. Román against defendant Julián Castro was entered on November 21, 2016. ECF #104. Final Judgment is now entered in favor of plaintiff against defendant in the amount of \$1,030,000.00 (One Million Thirty-Thousand Dollars and No Cents), with post-judgment interest allowed on the Judgment on the Verdict to the extent authorized by law. The Court further orders defendant to restore 634.2 hours of annual leave, 235.15 hours of sick leave, and 45.5 hours of comp time to plaintiff's leave account.
