

## Information Provided by Corporate Traveler USA

### NEW TRAVEL REGULATIONS REGARDING FACE COVERINGS:

- **American:** Effective May 11, 2020, American Airlines will require all customers traveling to wear a face covering (or mask) while on board their aircraft. [LINK](#)
- **Delta:** Effective May 4, 2020, face coverings will be required starting in the check-in lobby and across Delta touch points including Delta Sky Clubs, boarding gate areas, jet bridges and on board the aircraft -- except during meal service. Anyone who cannot keep a face covering in place, including children, will not be required to wear one. [LINK](#)
- **United:** Effective May 4, 2020, United will mandate all travelers to wear a face covering. They will be providing them free to their customers. [LINK](#)
- **JetBlue:** Effective May 4, 2020, all customers must wear face coverings (including scarves, bandannas or other forms of face protection) during travel. Young children who are not able to maintain a face covering on their own are exempt from this policy . [LINK](#)
- **Alaska:** Effective May 11, 2020, face masks will be mandatory for guests and for Alaska Airlines and Horizon Air employees who cannot maintain six feet of social distance from guests or co-workers, starting May 4. This includes pilots, flight attendants and customer service agents. [LINK](#)
- **Southwest:** Effective May 11, 2020, coverings or masks will be required for Customers starting May 11. If you forget your mask at home, one will be available for you. [LINK](#)
