



Who is M2Gen?

M2Gen is an oncology-focused health informatics solutions company with the mission to help patients gain access to the best treatments by leveraging clinical and molecular data to accelerate the discovery, development and delivery of tailored and more personalized therapies. M2Gen's approach is to integrate clinical and molecular data from cancer patients who consent to an observational study called Total Cancer Care (TCC) Protocol. Patients donate their clinical data and specimens throughout their lifetime leading to new biomarker discovery, clinical trial matching, and population studies examining comparative treatment effectiveness. Creating in silico communities based on genotype and phenotype forms the basis for deep learning and pattern recognition to predict events.

We're searching for a: Chief Medical Officer - Oncologist and Epidemiologist

The Chief Medical Officer (CMO) is a key member of the Senior Executive Team. The CMO is responsible for identifying the challenges associated with novel target-based cancer therapies and developing data driven approaches to address those challenges. The CMO will represent the voice of the patient and healthcare providers at the highest levels of the organization internally, and will be the primary medical spokesperson and ambassador for M2Gen and its partners including patient groups, healthcare providers and researchers, customers (e.g. pharmaceutical manufacturers), government and regulatory authorities, professional associations and corporate partners.

The education required for this role is:

- **MD/DO or equivalent in Oncology, Epidemiology**

To be successful in this role, we require:

- 10 years+ combined experience in 1) clinical practice (direct patient care) 2) industry drug development and commercialization and / or 3) clinical research (preferably at an NCI Designated Cancer Center)
- 10+ years of oncology and clinical trial experience
- Experience in clinical research, including clinical trials and experience working at, or with, pharmaceutical companies

We prefer a candidate who also has:

5+ years of clinical experience in epidemiology
5+ years biostatistics

Additional skills and / or specialized training we are looking for:

Required:

- 5+ years demonstrated experience in a highly organized, fast paced medical and supervisory role
- Knowledge of relevant FDA regulations and guidelines
- Experience in interactions with health agencies such as NIH, NCI, FDA, etc.



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- Experience with, or strong knowledge of, Oncology drug development
 - Experience working with academic medical centers, in particular NCI cancer centers
 - Excellent knowledge of the competitive environment for drugs in the Hematology/Oncology marketplace and in research and development pipelines
 - Must have entrepreneurial spirit with experience in an early stage company environment

Preferred:

- 5+ years experience within the following areas: molecular oncology, clinical cancer genomics, molecular profiling, genomic analyses, molecular driven research studies, molecular driven clinical trials, computational biology, bioinformatics, clinical trial matching

The Chief Medical Officer - Oncologist and Epidemiologist is also responsible for:

- Overseeing the management of the ORIEN network. The ORIEN Network is comprised of several NCI designated cancer centers and community cancer centers that have agreed to use the TCC protocol and consent to follow patients throughout their lifetime. The ORIEN members allow patient data to be shared with M2Gen for commercialization and inter-member projects
- Managing the Scientific Affairs Team
- Expanding the clinical network
- Providing regulatory and medical guidance and direction for Clinical and Life Sciences division
