

Admission Process in Detail

- Receipt of application and supporting documentation;
- 18 months prior to commencement, the applicant and at least one parent/guardian will be requested to attend an interview at the College;
- Prior to interview, Senior School applicants are expected to have undertaken an academic profile assessment. The results of this assessment will be discussed - along with other supporting documentation at the interview;
- At the interview, the Head of Middle Years/Head of Senior Years will:
 - a) Review most recent school reports and test profiles
 - b) Identify the applicant's range of interests and explain the vision, values, goals, policies and expectations of the College
 - c) Seek current information from the parents relevant to the applicant's social, emotional, medical and/or learning strengths and weaknesses
- After the interview the application is reviewed to establish that:
 - a) The needs of the applicant can be met successfully; and
 - b) Should a vacancy exist, the College may offer the parents a place at the College for their child
- To accept the offer, the parents must return the following to the College within 14 days of the offer:
 - a) The Acceptance of Place
 - b) The non-refundable Entrance Fee
