

## Out of Center Sleep Testing (OCST) – Updated July 2012

**OBJECTIVE:** To document the knowledge and skills required to educate and instruct patients, administer portable monitoring devices (PM) and score out of center sleep recordings.

**OUTCOME ASSESSMENT:** Outcome is determined by the assurance of patient safety and successful completion and accurate scoring of the test. This competency evaluation tool provides an objective assessment of the performance of the polysomnographic technologist, polysomnographic technician and polysomnographic trainee.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

The evaluator assesses the employee in the performance of the competency, indicating either a (**Yes**) the employee is competent or a (**No**) the employee is not competent with the process. Competency is met when the employee performs the competency according to accepted standards and guidelines. For every (**No**) a plan for correction should be outlined with a timeline for retesting. The correction plan and timeline must be documented in the comments section.
