Budget and Estimate Guide

Thank you for your interest in updating your cabinets with Fresh Faced Cabinets.

Everyone can be at different stages of planning a home improvement project. We've developed this three step process that helps save time and effort no matter where you are in the process.

The 3 Step Pricing Process:

1. Budget Guidelines

- The Budget Guidelines listed below are to help you budget. The listed price ranges for our services are meant as a resource for those in the early planning stages.

2. Online Estimates

- When you are ready, the next step is to estimate your specific project. Follow the simple instructions in the section for Online Estimates. This can take around 2-4 business days depending on the complexity of your project.

3. In-Home Consultation

- Once we've narrowed down your selections and pricing, it's time to have fun! We'll visit with samples and design choices, do a field measurement, and finalize the bid. Whenever you're ready to start your project, we'll require a 50% deposit.

Step 1: Budget Guidelines

Our Budget Guidelines are a great place to start planning your project.

Cabinet Painting: Your Budget = \$2,500 - \$5,000

- Cabinet Painting
 - HVLP Spray finish cabinets and doors done in home.
 - Small/Average Kitchens will range between \$2500-\$4000, Larger Kitchens \$4000-\$5000.
- Crown/Under-Cabinet Molding
 - Molding can be additional to the painting service for an inexpensive but dramatic Refresh.
 - Typical costs range between \$500-\$1500 depending on size of kitchen.
- Partial Updates: Islands and Peninsulas
 - It's become popular to have the island or peninsula a bold dramatic color.
 - Add Panels and molding to a plain back and sides of the island or peninsula.
 - Cost \$500-\$2000 depending on paint or refacing, and size.



Cabinet Re-Dooring: Your Budget = Starting at \$2,000 - \$6,000 depending on size of kitchen and style.

- Replacing Doors Only
 - It is often possible to only replace the doors. This is a great option if you like the color of the cabinets, but the doors are out of style or badly worn/damaged.
 - Very common if you have white, thermofoil doors that have discolored or are delaminating.
 - We have a large selection of wood stains or colors to match existing cabinet colors.
 - We commonly add matching end panels on cabinets and islands to facilitate color match and add elegance to your kitchen design.
 - Adding Crown Molding is another great cost effective addition when re-dooring.



Cabinet Refacing: Your Budget = \$4,000 - \$12,000 *Best Value Compared to New Cabinets*

- Full Cabinet Refacing
 - Replace Doors and Reface Cabinet fronts and end panels.
 - Provides the most dramatic effect allowing you to change style, wood specie, and color.
 - Selections are comparable to a full custom kitchen; creativity and unique designs are encouraged! If you see a picture on-line, we can find the style to match.
 - Door prices vary greatly due to door quality, style, and finish options. This pricing breakdown is a rough guide, contact us for an Online Estimate for your particular project.
 - \$4,000-\$6,000 - Small Kitchens in all Door styles. Average Kitchens in Economy Door Styles.
 - \$6,000-\$10,000 - Average Kitchens in most common Traditional Door Styles.
 - \$8,000-\$12,000 - Average Kitchens in Premium Door Styles. Large Kitchens in Traditional Door Styles.
 - \$12,000+ Large Kitchens with ornate features and Premium Door styles.



Refacing + Cabinet Accessories: Your Budget = \$6,000-\$15,000

- Full Cabinet Refacing plus minor layout changes
 - Adding/removing select cabinets or creating islands. (Changes would not include moving any appliances or sinks in base cabinets.)
 - New islands would require the services of a licensed electrician.
- See the above price ranges for Cabinet Refacing to give you an idea where pricing may start, knowing that pricing will go up depending on the scope of work to be added. Contact us for a consultation for this service.



Step 2: Online Estimates

Personalized Online Estimates: Provided Free

How can we provide fairly accurate estimates online? From good pictures, and possibly one or two email or phone descriptions of your desired updates.

Painting and Refacing are priced by the cabinet surface area in square feet. There are common cabinet and appliance sizes in every kitchen. Using those common sizes we are able to accurately scale all the cabinets to get the necessary measurements.

In general, if you want a new look for your cabinets, we have an option for any budget. Pricing for Cabinet Refacing can vary greatly depending on the quality and finish of the doors, so we often provide pricing at different design levels from which you can choose.

The biggest reason a price can change slightly during the In-Home Consultation is encountering issues requiring additional preparation prior to painting or install. Describing or photographing any areas of cabinet damage can avoid any additional charges at the field measure.

The Final Step: Free In-Home Consultations

If you do decide to work with us, we will work to finalize a detailed contract, collect a 50% cash, check or credit card payment, and provide a preliminary schedule for your install.
