### SUPPORT, AND ONGOING DEVELOPMENT

*Start strong and continue to access support to continually improve your craft.*

**Startup Teacher Training:** A blended learning experience for new teachers where educators complete a series of screencasts and investigate curriculum materials and connect with the Uncharted Learning team for questions.

**INCMarketplace Support:** Access help to setup your e-commerce account, establish account settings and base website, and link your school/district account to a processing system.

**Uncharted Learning National Summit:** A one day conference experience where educators and administrators attend workshops focused curriculum enhancements, entrepreneurship, project based learning, and volunteers for programs. Attendees collaborate with the greater Uncharted Learning Community to share strategies and best practices.

**Admin/Leadership Consult Meeting:** Discussion with a school's leadership to assess program implementation strengths and challenges.

**Member Success Coach:** Support person to help educators navigate the curriculum and share thoughts and ideas. Extra support is given to first year program educators. Meetings can be set up through email or calendly.
