Database Statistics May 2016

As at the end of **May 2016**, the OAG database had **909 airlines** of which **770** operated under their own designator

During the month, 99.6% of all schedules were updated





Dynamic Messages

The daily average amount delivered was 115.354

SSM (Standard Schedule Messages)


151 airlines supplied direct SSM messages into the OAG database

The average daily number of SSM messages processed was 48,432 with the total number of SSM messages processed throughout May being 1,501,398

The average % of the OAG database refreshed daily, as a result of SSM updates, was **27.6%**


