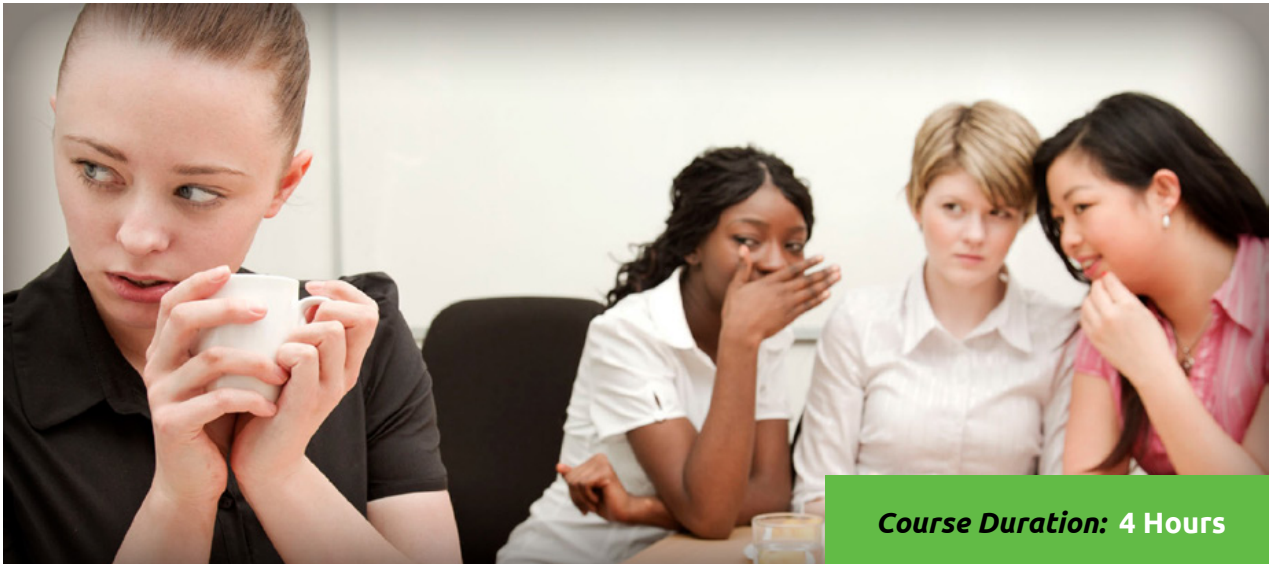




## Workplace Violence and **Bullying Course**
