CMS provides a robust, if somewhat confusing, portal for eCQM resources. Primarily you'll want to bookmark this page for measure specification information. From here, you can download the measure specifications and review the release notes.

Make sure you select the appropriate reporting period.

Provided by the National Library of Medicine (NLM), the Value Set Authority Center (VSACV) is where you obtain the value sets for the eQMs. You can download packages in multiple file formats from the downloads page on VSAC's website. The value sets are available as a complete set, as well as value sets per measure. You will be required to login with [Unified Medical Language System® Metathesaurus License](#) credentials, also available through the VSAC website.
