

Profiling Protocol: COVID-19 Decontamination Debris

Date: April 8, 2020 UPDATE

Covanta Environmental Solutions (CES) offers secure and sustainable Energy from Waste disposal of COVID-19 Decontamination Debris (Covid-19 Debris). Customers must have followed decontamination procedures established by the Centers of Disease Control (CDC) and must follow this Profiling Protocol. Please note: Any materials managed as Regulated Medical Waste (RMW) must be profiled separately with CES Healthcare Solutions – please contact Les Griffith – 862.222.5792.

Material Characterization Form (MCF):

- Customer must complete MCF for Covid-19 Debris.
 - o Pre-completed MPF MCF provided
 - NOTE: CES Myerstown requires WRS Profile provided
 - o Pre-completed EFW MCF provided
- An Authorized Representative from Customer or Cleaning/Decontamination contractor shall sign the MCF
- If a customer has multiple decontamination sites only one MCF is needed
- Note: State specific profile requirements apply (example PA-FormU)

COVID-19 Decontamination Waste Certification:

- An Authorized Representative of the Cleaning/Decontamination contractor shall complete and sign the COVID-19 Decontamination Waste Certification
- One fully executed COVID-19 Decontamination Waste Certification is required for each waste generation site.
- Required to be submitted initially with the MCF and accompany each delivery

Covid-19 Debris Approval:

- CES will issue a separate Covid-19 Debris approval.
- Covid-19 Debris is not acceptable to be shipped under any other existing CES Approval



Packaging and Delivery Requirements at EfW and MPF:

- Double Inner Poly Liner
 - o All COVID-19 Debris will be double bagged in a 3 mil or greater thickness poly bag prior to being placed in outer packaging.
 - o All Bags will be tied or zip tied closed.
- Acceptable Packaging Types
 - o Cardboard Boxes Up to 2'x2'x3'
 - o Fiber Drums up to 55 gallon size
 - O Labpack / Hazmat Boxes up to 66 gallon size
 - o Plastic Pails up to 7 gallons
- Other Packaging will be considered on a Case by Case basis
- Unacceptable Packaging:
 - Any metal containers of any size
 - o Super Sacks poly woven bags
 - Poly Drums any size
 - O Cubic Yard Boxes, Pallet Boxes, Waste Wranglers
 - Bulk Deliveries Roll-offs, Walking Floor Trailers, End Dump
- Other Packaging Requirements
 - O All External Containers must be Secured to a standard pallet with banding or adequate shrink wrap that can be moved with a pallet jack
 - o Pallets must be no taller than 72" tall.

Labeling Requirements:

- Each movable unit will include labeling to include:
 - o Non-Hazardous Label and CES Approval Number
 - o Covid-19 Decontamination Debris Covid-19 T&D Waste
