


What is Pure Green?

To help ESPO with their commitment to environmental responsibility, 336GWh of Pure Green has been secured exclusively for ESPO customers at 0.075p/kWh (this charge will be reviewed annually and is subject to change). Pure Energy comes from 100% renewable sources (solar, wind, and hydro/wave) but doesn't include biomass.

Why Pure Green?

Using Pure Green energy means all participating ESPO customers can report zero emissions for electricity under the GHG Protocol Corporate Standards, Scope 2, as the electricity they use can be matched to Renewable Energy Guarantees of Origin (REGOs). We will provide certification of the renewable sources to any customers who request it.
