




Flirtin' With Pisaster



STEVE HOLLAND IS MANY THINGS: a talented musician with a rock n roll soul, a risk taker, a drifter, and a free spirit. But one thing he is not, is boring! Steve was born in 1954 in Alabama to a military family. He spent his childhood as the typical military child, moving from navy base to navy base all over the world wherever his father was stationed. After leaving home at the age of 17, he co-founded a rock n roll band in Jacksonville, Florida by the name of Molly Hatchet. Steve spent the next 30 plus years on the road doing what he enjoyed most, playing the electric

guitar and Flirtin' With Disaster. His travels took him all over the United States and as far as Germany. As one can imagine, the stories of his life are endless... a bit colorful at times, and quite different from the average American guy. However, unlike the glamour that is portrayed by so many musicians, his journey was not always kind to him. Through the years he has accrued many battle wounds, but he also has vivid memories and a friendship that has stood the test of time. John Pappas and Steve have known one another for 29 years, and John, who is also a talented musician,



has walked through all of the ups and downs with Steve. Their friendship is best defined as a brotherhood, and is a big part of Steve being alive today.

In 2009, Steve had a major health crisis. He has no living relatives and John became his biggest supporter, encourager, caregiver, and guardian. After having two major back to back surgeries, both with unpredictable outcomes, he began rehabilitation. During this time Steve chose to make Magnolia Manor his home. Steve, who values his privacy, found Magnolia Manor to be a secure, safe, nurturing environment to wake up to every day, and with many friends among the staff and residents, Magnolia Manor is a good fit for him. As a bonus, John is able to visit with him regularly. Steve is able to continue his work out sessions daily on the campus during his long-term physical rehabilitation. Because of his determination and the care and support he receives, he is doing well. Steve is a kind soul with an intriguing history, but if you ask him, he will say, "I am just an old rock star".
