

DID YOU KNOW?

Mary Lyon traveled far and wide to secure the **funds and materials** needed to open Mount Holyoke, carrying the donations in her green velvet bag.

Donations ranged from six cents to \$1,000, and included quilts and bedding from women's sewing circles and necessary items like stoves and furniture.
