### **Company description**

Altenburger is a Swiss law firm with offices in Zurich, Geneva and Lugano and an experienced team of lawyers and tax experts who distinguish themselves through cultural and linguistic diversity.

#### Pain points

- As a law firm, we sign a variety of documents every day that require one or more signatures.
- Our employees are often on the road even abroad. This makes obtaining handwritten signatures a logistical challenge.
- Submissions to authorities are often time-critical and must comply with formal requirements.
- We need a solution that works regardless of device, browser and location.
- We are increasingly working all over Europe, which is why the solution must also be compatible with the EU regulation eIDAS.

#### **Solution by Skribble**

- We can easily invite others to sign the tedious process of obtaining signatures is done digitally and without detours.
- Invited people sign immediately, no matter where and from which device they are working.
- We decide for each individual document whether we want to sign it according to Swiss or EU law.
- Skribble has trained us within a very short period of time for independent identification verification with Swisscom's ID app. This means that we can now enable every employee internally for QES in just a few minutes.
