After completing the **Teaming for a Purpose Microlearning**, you will be able to:

- · understand the theory of teams.
- · apply the theory of teams to team dynamics.
- · explain the process of building teams.
- analyse the role of the team leader in building teams.
- evaluate and improve the effectiveness of a team.
- · build teams to achieve goals and objectives.

The below captures a more detailed presentation of the skills you will acquire:

MODULE 1: THEORY OF TEAMS	 Compare the characteristics of a team and team interaction with those of a group. Describe different types of teams in terms of their unique roles and characteristics. Motivate the importance of teams for achieving workplace goals and objectives, with examples of the contributions of teams.
MODULE 2: APPLY THE THEORY OF TEAMS TO TEAM DYNAMICS	 Explain the dynamics of teams in terms of practical examples. Analyse the reasons for disagreements and conflict that could disrupt the functioning of the team, with reference to interpersonal and other factors. Identify unique challenges presented by different types of teams with specific reference to crossfunctional and virtual teams.
MODULE 3: EXPLAIN THE PROCESS OF BUILDING TEAMS	 Explain the process of building a team with reference to the steps in the process Analyse the stages of team development in terms of the human behaviour that drives the different stages.
MODULE 4: ANALYSE THE ROLE OF THE TEAM LEADER IN BUILDING TEAMS	 Explain the role of the team leader in relation to improving team effectiveness. Consider the impact of different leadership styles in relation to the leader's role in promoting team effectiveness. Describe techniques for the constructive management of team dynamics and conflict with specific reference to promoting trust, cohesion, creativity and productivity.
MODULE 5: EVALUATE AND IMPROVE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF A TEAM	 Evaluate the functioning of a team against the characteristic of high performance teams. Develop an action plan for improving the effectiveness of the team.

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The duration and process

The student will complete the Test the Teaming for a Purpose Microlearning online in a one and a half-week period. It involves a combination of online learning components, practical workplace applications, various videos, structured learning content and assignments online. The student has access to templates and tools to complete the assessments effectively.

Once you have completed all the tasks, assignments and assessments for the Microlearning the student receives feedback on their progress. Assessments for Microlearning are completed every eight weeks and your submission will be assessed after the closing date (see dates further down). Once marked, you will get your results (either determined as competent or not yet competent).

Where this short course can take you

Upon successful completion you are awarded the muchcoveted Stellenbosch Graduate Institute Teaming for a Purpose Microlearning Certificate. This Microlearning is recognised by SAQA (South African Qualifications Authority) with the unit standard name of Build teams to achieve goals and objectives and unit standard # 252037. On successful completion, you will have acquired 6 credits at an NQF (National Qualifications Framework) Level 5.


