# IRELAND, SCOTLAND & ENGLAND

#### Day 1: Board your flight to Ireland.

#### Day 2: Dublin

- · Meet with your tour director at **Dublin Airport**.
- Board your private motor coach for a sightseeing tour of the capital city of the Republic of Ireland. View landmarks like the River Liffey, the General Post Office, and Grafton Street.
- Stroll through the Temple Bar district toward Trinity College, University of Dublin, established by royal charter in 1592.

#### Day 3: Dublin

- Explore **Dublin Castle** in the heart of the city. Head to the lower levels of the estate to discover why Dublin was named after a "Black Pool."
- Board your private motor coach and travel past Phoenix
  Park to Kilmainham Gaol. The former prison held many Irish revolutionaries during the fight for independence.
- · Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, built in 1191.
- Take advantage of the opportunity to Experience Gaelic Games and learn about Ireland's traditional sports.

#### Day 4: Edinburgh

- Board your private motor coach and head to the airport for your flight to Scotland.
- After your arrival at Edinburgh Airport, settle into your hotel before embarking on a walking tour of the Scottish capital. Discover the Old Town's medieval atmosphere as you wander through narrow passages and winding alleys. See how the New Town impacted European urban planning.
- Explore **Edinburgh**'s darker side on a ghost tour of the **Blair Street Underground Vaults**.

#### Day 5: Edinburgh

- Experience Scotland's most famous attraction, Edinburgh Castle. Built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century, the fortress keeps watch over the city from its perch atop Castle Rock.
- Stroll Calton Hill, which houses the headquarters of the Scottish government at St. Andrew's House.
- Explore the idyllic **Holyrood Park**, a royal park with 650 acres of rolling hills. Aside from its natural sights, the park also features **Holyrood Palace** and many ancient ruins.
- Hike to **Arthur's Seat**, the park's main peak.
- Enjoy free time on the **Royal Mile**, a historic series of streets connecting Holyrood Palace and Edinburgh Castle.

#### Day 6: Central Scotland

- Travel to **Stirling**, the historical center of the country connecting the Scottish Highlands and Lowlands.
- Step into the world of Renaissance kings and queens at **Stirling** Castle.
- Journey to Loch Lomond and The Trossachs National Park, offering stunning views of the Scottish highlands.
- Enjoy a round-trip cruise from **Tarbet** to the charming rural community of **Inversnaid**.

#### Day 7: London

- Depart on a high-speed train from Edinburgh's **Haymarket Station** to London's **St. Pancras Station**, enjoying the beautiful scenery along the way.
- Meet your local guide for a half-day walking tour of the British capital. Get a glimpse of London landmarks like the Houses of Parliament, the Big Ben clock tower, Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace, and Trafalgar Square.
- Take a ride on the **London Eye**, the world's tallest cantilevered observation wheel, rotating 450 feet above the River Thames.

#### Day 8: London

- Visit Westminster Abbey, a major institution of British history and burial place of Isaac Newton, Charles Darwin, and many kings and queens of the Empire.
- Walk through **Trafalgar Square** on the way to **Embankment Pier.** Board the **Thames Clipper** for a sightseeing cruise don't forget to snap photos as you pass under the **Tower Bridge**.
- Enter the Tower of London, famous home of the Crown Jewels.
- Stroll through **St. Dunstan-in-the-East**, a garden amidst the ruins of a parish destroyed during the Second World War.
- · Savor British delicacies at a traditional English pub.

#### Day 9: Stratford-upon-Avon

- Board your private motor coach and travel to Stratford-upon-Avon, the birthplace of William Shakespeare. Walk around the charming streets of this historic village. Explore its history and attractions, many related to the famous playwright.
- Retrace Shakespeare's footsteps as you visit the family's five houses in town
- Return to London. On the way, view Gatwick's famous Warwick Castle.
