SAMPLE ITINERARY

SAN DIEGO PERFORMANCE TOUR

Day 1:

- Meet your Tour Director and board your private motor coach.
- Explore Balboa Park. The 1,200 acre urban park was established in the 1870s, making it one of the oldest public recreation sites in the U.S. The complex features a variety of California's distinct architectural styles, and the buildings and grounds house over 50 museums, gardens, and attractions. Top destinations include the Botanical Building, the Old Globe Theatre, the Spreckels Organ Pavilion, and Casa del Prado – the home of the San Diego Youth Symphony.
- Take advantage of an opportunity to **perform** for fellow visitors at **Balboa Park**.
- Take in a performance by the **San Diego Symphony** at **Copley Symphony Hall**. The venue first opened in 1929 as the Fox Theatre.

Day 2:

- Head into the wild at the San Diego Zoo Safari Park! Witness herds of exotic and endangered animals roaming the 1,800 acres of free-range enclosures. The park is also home to a highly successful California condor breeding program and the largest veterinary hospital in the world.
- Enjoy a performance by the **San Diego Dance Theater**. Founded in 1972, the professional dance company is known for opening doors to artists of diverse ethnicities, ages, and physical ability through innovative and original pieces, and by providing training to young, up-and-coming performers.

Day 3:

- Experience underwater adventure at **SeaWorld** in San Diego's **Mission Bay Park**. This theme park, oceanarium, outdoor aquarium, and marine mammal park offers a fun and interactive way to learn through rides, shows, and tours.
- · Perform for fellow park-goers at SeaWorld San Diego.
- Visit Old Town San Diego, a historic area dating back to 1769. The neighborhood includes Old Town San Diego State Historic Park and Presidio Park, where you can admire historic buildings like original adobes, San Diego's first newspaper office, and the Serra Museum.
- Get swept up in the magic of musicals when you attend a performance at a **Broadway San Diego** venue.

Day 4:

- Explore one of San Diego's nine artistic districts on a walking tour. Options include La Jolla, home of the Athenaeum Music & Arts Library and the eclectic La Jolla Music Society, Mission Valley, where Cygnet Theatre produces impressive and bold shows, and North and South Park, known for live music ranging from big name bands to jazz to indie rock.
- Catch a movie at the **Reuben H. Fleet Science Center**'s distinctive **Heikoff Giant Dome**, home of an IMAX theater.
- Depart for home.
