Day 1: Board your flight to Brussels

Day 2: Brussels

- Meet with your tour leader at the airport
- Take a guided tour of **Brussels** where you will see the center square, **Grand Place (Grote Markt), Saint-Michel Cathedral** and see the sights from the top of the **Mont des Arts**.

Day 3: Brussels - Ypres

- Travel from Brussels to Ypres.
- Visit the Ypres Salient, the home to some of the most remarkable battles of the First World War. Stop in at the Essex Farm Cemetery, the site that inspired Lieutenant-Colonel John McCrae to write 'In Flanders Fields," and the Flanders Fields Museum.
- Experience the **Tyne Cot British Cemetery**, which sits upon the land that acted as a stage for one of the deadliest battles in history.
- Discover the Sanctuary Wood Museum and the German Cemetery at Langemark, to provide your students with a different perspective on WWI.
- Attend the Last Post at the Menin Memorial Gate. This stirring performance happens at the memorial that bears the names of the 54,896 British soldiers who were killed on August 16th, 1917.

Day 4: Ypres - Vimy - Bayeux

- Travel to Vimy from Ypres.
- Visit Vimy Ridge, the historic site that was the location of the most notable victory in Canada's military history. You will get a scenic view of the site and have a chance to learn about this significant area.
- Explore the Beaumont-Hamel Newfoundland Memorial Park to tour the infamous trenches that defined combat in WWI, have lunch at the Ocean Villas Tea Room and finish the day at the Thiepval Memorial, the largest British war memorial in the world.
- Transfer to Bayeux.

Day 5: Bayeux

- Tour the D-Day Beaches, the Sword, Juno and Gold, which are locations brimming with historical significance. Stop at the Pegasus Bridge and the new museum.
- Visit the D-Day memorial site: the **Juno Beach Centre** to see several exhibits that mark the efforts of Canadian soldiers during World War II

Travel to the **Bény-sur-Mer Canadian Military Cemetery** and pay respect to the soldiers killed during the early stages of the Battle of Normandy.

Day 6: Bayeux

- Start the day at the Longues-sur-Mer with a visit to the artillery guns at the battery. Continue on for a stop at the American Cemetery and Memorial with a beautiful view over Omaha Beach, and finish off with a breathtaking visit to Pointe du Hoc and La Cambe.
- Spend the rest of the day enjoying the sights and sounds of **Bayeux** on your leisure time.

Day 7: Paris

- Take a guided tour of the City of Lights where you will see the revolutionary square La Bastille where the storming of the Bastille prison took place. Stroll down one of the most famous streets in the world, the Champs Elysées and see the stunning Arc de Triomphe. Explore Les Invalides, the tomb of Napoleon and see L'Opéra which was founded in 1669 by Louis XIV.
- Experience the **Eiffel Tower** and those feeling daring can take the elevator to see bird's eye views of the Parisian landscape.

Day 8: Paris

- Explore the stunning Palace de Versailles with a guided tour of the Grand Apartment, the Hall of Mirrors and the King and Queen's suites.
- Enjoy a relaxing cruise along the **River Seine** on the famous **Bateaux Mouches**.

Day 9: Paris

 Spend the day exploring Paris on your own. You can head to Montmartre to see the Basilica of the Sacré Cœur, stroll through the streets in search of pastry shops or wander around the Louvre and see the Mona Lisa.

Day 10: Depart to the airport for your flight home
