GERMANY & AUSTRIA - 11 Days | European Student Music Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to Munich

Day 2: Munich

- Meet with your tour leader at the airport
- Enjoy a half-day guided tour of the city where you will see the 'Castle of the Nymph,' Nymphenburg Palace, the oldest church in the district, St. Peter's Church and the Olympic Grounds.

Day 3: Munich

- Start the day with a visit to the Alte Pinakothek, one of the most significant art museums in Europe with over 800 paintings ranging from the Middle Ages to the Rococo era.
- In the afternoon, travel to Dachau Memorial, where the first concentration camp was established by the Nazi regime in 1933. You will experience the museum and visit two reconstructed barracks to learn about horrible conditions the prisoners had to endure.
- Possible informal a cappella recital at Dachau Memorial.

Day 4: Schwangau - Innsbruck

- Depart for Innsbruck
- Stop at Neuschwanstein Castle along the way. This 19th century Romanesque Revival palace is one of the most famous castles in the world and has fantastic views of the Alps.
- Continue on to Innsbruck.
- Take a walk with your tour leader through the Old Town
 where you will see the Baroque, 16th century Imperial Palace
 or Hofburg, the Triumphal Arch and the Golden Roof, which
 housed the very first government and administrative
 activities of the Habsburg Dynasty.

Day 5: Innsbruck

- Begin the day with a visit to the Tyrolean Regional Heritage Museum.
- In the afternoon, visit the Bergisel Ski Jump which towers above Innsbruck offering gorgeous views of the city.
- Free time in Innsbruck.
- Possible performance at a local church.

Day 6: Salzburg

- Travel to Salzburg.
- Enjoy a guided tour of the city where you will see the oldest monastery with a continuous history, St. Peter's Abbey, the 17th century Salzburg Cathedral and Mirabell Gardens, which was one of the shooting locations for 'The Sound of Music.'

 Visit the Geburtshaus where Amadeus Mozart was born in 1756 and Mozart's house where he lived from 1773-1780.

Day 7: Salzburg

- Discover the city with a river cruise where you will see the Old Town and glide through the natural landscape along the river Salzach.
- Experience an outdoor performance at Mirabell Gardens.

Day 8: Vienna

- Travel to Vienna from Salzburg.
- Take a guided tour of Vienna to see the State Opera House, the neo-Greek style Parliament, the neo-Gothic style City Hall, the 13th century former Imperial Palace and St. Stephen's Cathedral.
- Included in the tour is a visit to the Central Cemetery where you will see the tombs and memorials of famous composers such as Beethoven, Mozart, the Strauss family and Brahms.

Day 9: Vienna

- Start the day with a visit to the House of Music, an interactive museum located in the heart of Vienna's first district. The installations will allow you to test your talent as a conductor for the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra or become a composer.
- Enjoy free time in the afternoon. Take a stroll along Mariahilfer Strasse, Vienna's longest shopping street, or stop off for coffee and a slice of Vienna's famous Sacher cake.
- Possible performance at a local venue.

Dav 10: Vienna

- Free time in the morning to discover the city.
- Possible service participation followed by a lunchtime recital at St. Stephen's Dom.
- Explore the Schoenbrunn Palace, the former imperial Rococo summer residence of the Habsberg monarchs which is one of the most important cultural monuments in Austria.

Day 11: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
