

NORMANDY, LOIRE & PARIS - 9 Days | European Student Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to Paris

Day 2: Étretat - Deauville - Trouville - Caen

- Arrive at Charles de Gaulle International Airport and meet your Tour Leader.
- Travel towards the beautiful region of Normandy.
- Don't forget your camera! Our first stop is at the chalky cliffs of Étretat for some fresh air. Stretch your legs as you hike to the foot of the gorgeous gate of Aval.
- Next stop Deauville Trouville.
- Experience the twin cities of Deauville and Trouville. Walk along the wooden boardwalk, the Promenade des Planches, and observe the charming villas of this seaside town.
- Next stop Caen.
- End the day with beloved French dishes, a sweet crêpe or savory galette, for dinner.

Day 3: Juno Beach - Beny-sur-Mer - Caen

- Start the day at the Caen Memorial, an interactive museum that focuses on the events that led to WWII.
- Depart for your afternoon tour of the Canadian landing beaches.
- Begin your journey at the Juno Beach Centre to see several exhibits that mark the efforts of Canadian soldiers during World War II. You will also see Juno Park and part of the famous Atlantic Wall.
- Discover the emblematic remembrance site of D-Day, Pointe du Hoc.
- Visit the Canadian Military Cemetery in Bény-sur-Mer and pay respect to the soldiers killed during the early stages of the Battle of Normandy
- Return to Caen for the night to experience a Normandy style dinner.

Day 4: Mont Saint-Michel - St Malo

- Depart for Mont Saint-Michel, an architectural marvel nestled on an island in the middle of the bay.
- Follow your Tour Leader through the medieval village to learn about the fascinating history of this architectural marvel and see the ramparts and Grande-Rue.
- Visit the Benedictine Abbey of Mont Saint-Michel. Granted a
 UNESCO World Heritage site in 1979, this stunning building sits at
 the very top of the island and offers beautiful views both inside
 and out.
- Travel to St Malo.
- Join your guide for a stroll through the fortified city. This coastal town was founded in the 1st century and has a Canadian connection - it is the birthplace of explorer Jacques Cartier.
- Enjoy a meal of Breton specialties with your group.

Day 5: Rochemenier - Tours

- Depart for the Loire Valley.
- Grab your sweater and head underground to the troglodyte village of Rochemenier. You will be guided through the museum before getting to explore this unique town on your own. Don't miss the chapel!

- Visit the Azay-le-Rideau Castle, which appears to rise from the waters of the Indre River, to discover the gorgeous chateau and gardens with an audio guide.
- Travel towards Tours for the evening.

Day 6: Chamboard - Paris

- Discover the famous double helix staircase inspired by Leonardo Da Vinci at **Chambord Castle**. Follow your local guide through one of the largest castles in the country and get a group photo during a stroll through the magnificent gardens.
- Travel to Paris, where you will be living like a Parisian with a 3-day metro pass for zones 1-3.
- Feeling daring? Soar to the top of the Eiffel Tower for breathtaking views of the city.

Day 7: Paris

- Start the day with a 3-hour guided tour of the City of Lights. You
 will meet in the gardens of the Palais-Royal and continue on to see
 the Place de la Concord, where King Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette
 were publicly executed, the Tuileries and the lively Latin Quarter.
- Head to Sainte-Chapelle to view the beautiful stained glass windows of this gothic church.
- Make sure you have good walking shoes, next stop is the hilly Montmartre. Stoll through this charming neighbourhood to see the Sacre Coeur Basilica from the top of the hill, the Wall of Love and the Moulin Rouge.

Day 8: Paris

- Start your day with an audio guided tour of the Musée du Louvre. You will be led through this maze to see the iconic Mona Lisa, and other masterpieces along the way.
- Make your way to the reverse pyramid at the Carrousel du Louvre on your free time.
- Explore the building that inspired The Phantom of the Opera, the Opéra Garnier. You will learn about the history and architecture as you are guided through this one-of-a-kind theatre.
- Stroll down one of the most famous streets in the world, the Champs Elysées and see the stunning Arc de Triomphe.
- All aboard! Savour the last bit of Paris as you listen to a commentary while cruising down the Seine River on a bateau-mouche.

Day 9: Depart to the airport for your flight home
